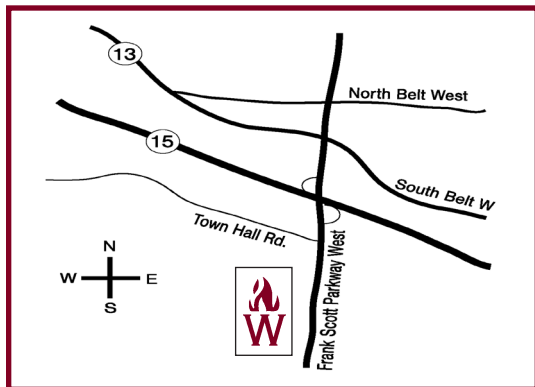


West High School

Belleville West is a new state of the art high school recently built on 126 acres south of Route 15 on Frank Scott Parkway West. The campus consists of a 360,000 sq. ft. educational facility, a football/soccer stadium encircled by an all weather 8 lane track, athletic facilities to accommodate tennis, softball, baseball, soccer, cross country and physical education. The educational facility contains a performing arts center, television studio, computer labs and numerous career and technology labs, in addition to classrooms that meet the educational curriculum of the district. Along with an outstanding physical plant, Belleville West is home to a 28-acre prairie grassland and conservation area and two wetland cells. Understanding the need to promote conservation, Belleville West offers opportunities for students to participate in hands on, real world activities in science.

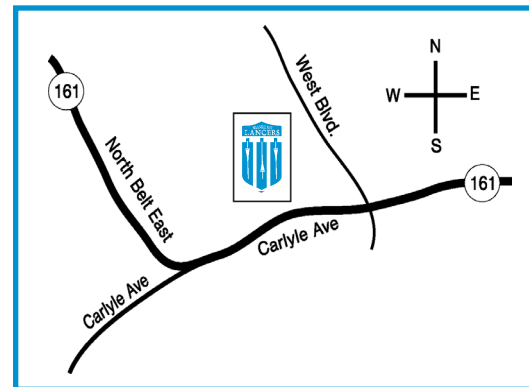

Belleville East is located on 62.75 acres of majestic wooded land, at the corner of West Boulevard and Carlyle Avenue. This beautiful college-like campus contains 19 instructional buildings, a football/soccer stadium encircled by an 8 lane all weather track and additional athletic facilities to accommodate cross country, baseball, softball and tennis. The educational facilities include a new state of the art performing arts center, cafeteria, computer labs and a variety of classrooms designed to meet the educational curriculum of the district. A new media center was completed at the end of the 2009 school year and does provide a beautiful new educational space for our students. In 2003-04, District 201 opened a new, \$60.3 million, 360,000 square foot West Campus and completed a \$18.2 million building and renovation project at the East Campus.

In addition, the District was selected to receive the 2008 Indoor Air Quality Tools for Schools Leadership Award, the "What Parents Want" Award given by School Match, a nationwide service that helps corporate employees and their families find schools that match the needs of their children.
