

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF BELLEVILLE TOWNSHIP HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT 201, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS, HELD OCTOBER 10, 2019, BELLEVILLE TOWNSHIP HIGH SCHOOL, 920 NORTH ILLINOIS ST, BELLEVILLE, ILLINOIS.

The meeting was called to order by Board President, Carol Eckert, at 5:00 pm.

Mr. Eiskant moved, seconded by Mr. Sauerwein, that a closed session be called at 5:00 pm. to discuss student disciplinary cases; pursuant to 5 ILCS 120/2 (c)(9), and pending or probable litigation against, affecting or on behalf of the public body, pursuant to 5 ILCS 120/2 (c)(11). The student is eligible for district approved online courses. Student "A" is unable to participate in any school activities including graduation ceremonies.
