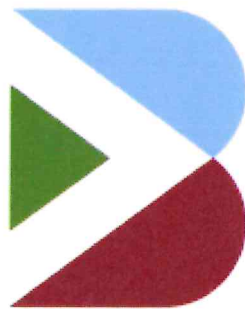

STRATEGIC PLAN

2024 - 2027

Belleville Township High School District #201 is located in Belleville IL and is comprised of three campuses, including Belleville East, Belleville West and the CAVE. BTHS #201 is the largest school district in St. Clair County with over 4700 students.

The Belleville East campus is located on 76 acres of majestic wooded land, at the corner of West Boulevard and Carlyle Avenue. This beautiful college-like campus contains 19 instructional buildings, a football/soccer stadium encircled by an 8 lane all-weather track and additional athletic facilities to accommodate cross country, baseball, softball and tennis. The educational facilities include a state of the art performing arts center, culinary and trades labs, and a variety of classrooms designed to meet the educational needs of our students.



Belleville West is a state-of-the-art high school built on 113 acres at the corner of Route 15 and Frank Scott Parkway West. The campus consists of a 360,000 square foot educational facility, a turf football/soccer stadium encircled by an 8-lane, all-weather track, along with athletic facilities to accommodate tennis, softball, baseball, cross country and physical education. It also contains a performing arts center, television studio, computer labs and numerous career and technology labs, in addition to classrooms that meet the educational needs of our students.



The Center for Academic and Vocational Excellence in Belleville Township High School District #201 is a state of the art facility designed to meet the needs of District #201 students and our community. Our facility offers in-demand vocational programs so that students can take advanced courses beyond what are offered on the main campuses. Students graduate with college credit and are ready to embark on their chosen career pathway. The CAVE is home to the district's alternative education center and our esports studio. The CAVE is also a field house for our many sports and activities, with indoor tennis courts, an indoor turf practice field, batting cages, a dance studio, and golf simulator.

The Strategic Planning Process began in September of 2023 when the Strategic Planning Committee met to discuss the process. A group of stakeholders and members of the Board of Education met as a steering committee; a SWOT (strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, threats) exercise helped identify potential areas of study.



In October 2023, a community wide survey was conducted. This survey asked for community feedback on facilities, curriculum, communication, finance, technology, student growth and achievement, and student well being. Open-ended questions were a part of the survey as well, asking the respondents the following questions:

- What are the greatest strengths of the BTHS #201 district?
- What are the greatest opportunities and/or improvements needed?
- What are the greatest challenges?
- What steps should BTHS #201 take in the next 3-5 years to improve?

597 individuals responded to the survey. On October 17 and 23, 2023, the committee met again to prioritize goal areas and returned on October 30, 2023 to draft a final plan for review.



The Strategic Plan for BTHS #201 published here is reflective of the entirety of the feedback from the steering committee, community survey, community stakeholder engagement meeting, and the Board of Education.

The final plan will be presented to the Board of Education in the Fall of 2023 with the launch of the plan to begin with staff and parents in the Spring of 2024.

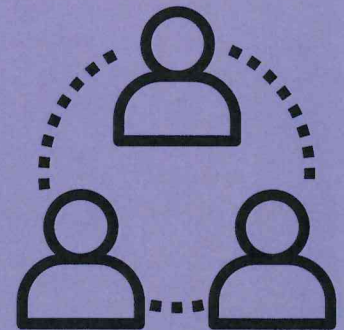
