
- 1. Take the Admissions Campus Tour



October 1st


Before you get started, here's what you need!

Get this NOW! The Student and Parent will each need a FSA ID# to complete the application.

Request your FSA ID# at http://fsaid.ed.gov

FAFSA Completion is NOW a graduation requirement. If you do NOT plan to submit your FAFSA, you MUST complete a Non-Participation Form/Waiver.


