The beginning of the 2026-2027 school year is just around the corner. In an effort to keep our records up-to-date and to continue to verify residency of our students, all sophomores, juniors and seniors are required to provide verification of their residence. **There are two possible scenarios:**

**Scenario #1**

The student lives at the same residence that was established last school year.

- ✓ Simply bring in a CURRENT utility bill for that address

**Scenario #2**

The student has moved from the residence established last school year.

- ✓ The process requires 3 proofs of residency – at least 2 from Category A. The categories are listed on the right.

**Category A**

- Occupancy Permit
- Current Utility Bill (water, gas, sewer, or electric) – may use 1
- Lease
- Home Ownership Title or Deed
- Home Owner or Rental Insurance Bill
- Mortgage Statement
- Current Real Estate Tax Bill

**Category B**

- Current Paycheck Stub with address in District 201
- Documentation of TANF/Approval Letter from Nutrition Program & Support Services
- Driver’s License with address in District 201

The Residency Verification will take place during registration/book pick-up. Registration will take place in the Commons. Enter through the Foyer doors labeled “Entrance Only,” and follow the directional signs to the Commons. The first station will be **Residency Verification and Schedule distribution**. We also ask that each student and/or guardian complete the Enrollment Data Verification Form that will be given to you at the same time as your schedule. This form is one final check to make sure all information in our student management system is correct and up-to-date. All other stations will be clearly marked. Please note the information below for the days and times your class is scheduled.

**There are a few more items that you will need to attend to during registration/book pick-up:**

- Student parking is available. The cost for a **parking permit is \$60.00**. Students must present a **valid Driver’s License** and **proof of insurance** to purchase a permit.
- Students have their own locker. Sharing lockers is prohibited. Students must provide their own locks. The bookstore sells locks for \$5.00 and you may purchase a lock at registration/book pick-up.
